Regeneration
This selection is to *force* the
system into regeneration.

REGENERATION



The unit will regenerate, also know as clean itself, at some frequency. This process is when the "brine" or salt will be utilized to clean the media inside the tall tank.

DID YOU KNOW?





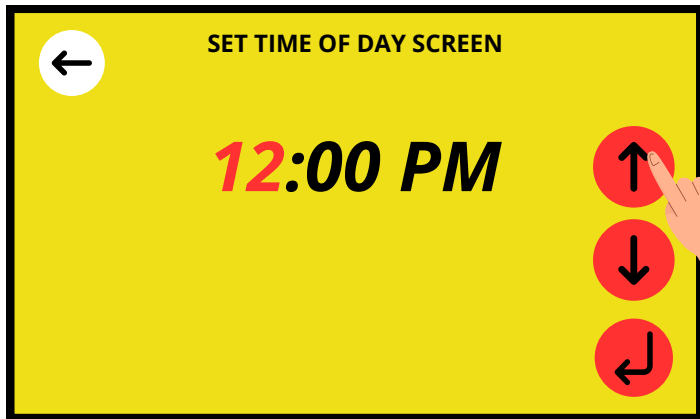
TIME

The most important thing you can do as the owner of a LuxSoft Water Softener is to ensure that time is always correct. This is important because your installation team has programmed the unit to **regenerate** at a certain time, generally at 2 AM. The unit can be programmed to regenerate at any time.

How to SET the Time

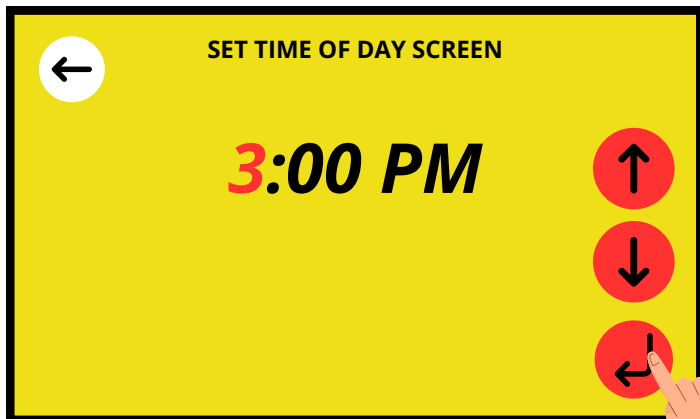


Place your finger over the time of day.
Press and Hold for 5 Seconds until
the screen changes.

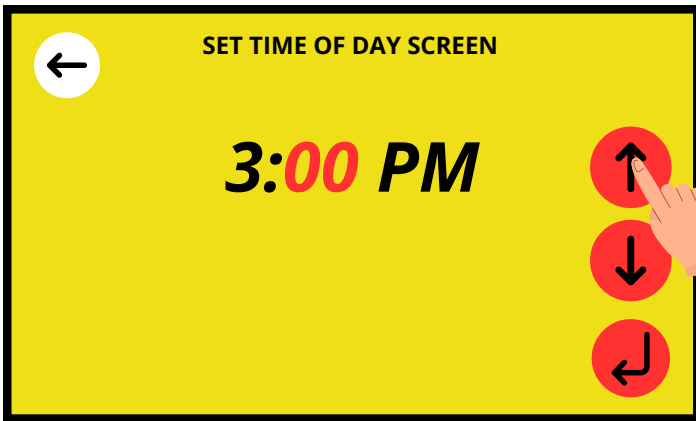


Adjust the HOUR by pressing
the up or down arrows.

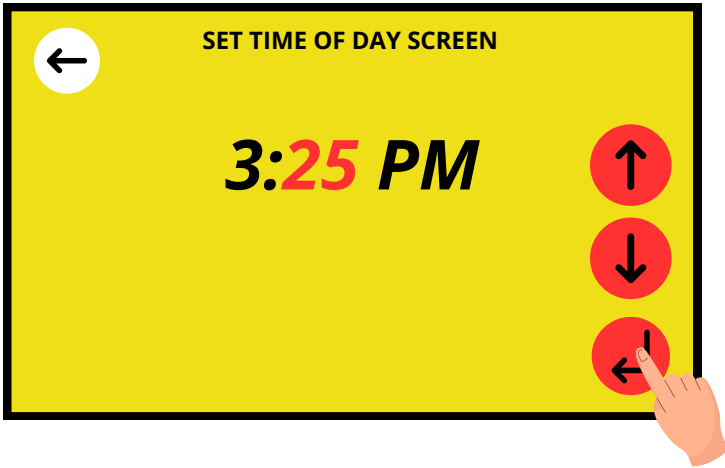
The HOURS need to adjusted to
account for AM or PM



Once the HOUR has been selected
press the enter arrow to set.



Adjust the MINUTES by pressing the up or down arrows.



Once the MINUTES have been selected press the enter arrow to set.

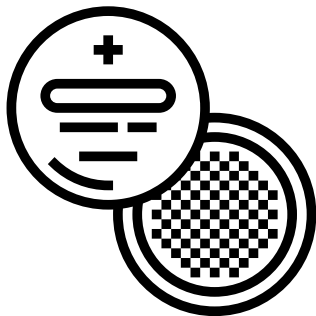


You have now programmed the time.

The unit DOES NOT account for daylight savings. Make sure to adjust the time when it is necessary.

Please note: during extended power outages your unit may "lose" time - similar to other appliances in your home.

There is a back up coin cell battery that will sustain the correct time for up to 8 hours. This battery will need to be replaced after frequent power outages or yearly.

BATTERY REPLACEMENT



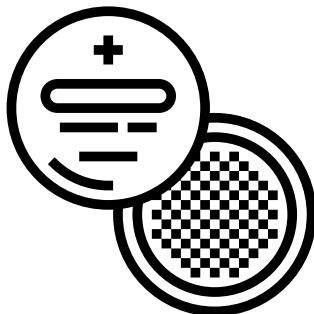
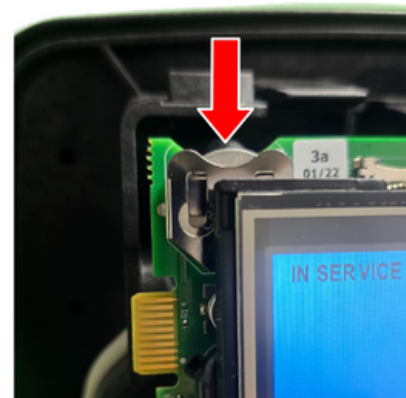
Gently lift tabs on the sides and pull plastic face plate toward you.

Battery is located here



Push up to remove battery

Insert a new CR-2032 Battery and gently press down to seat the battery in



Battery Required: CR 2032

BYPASS

Knowing where the bypass is and how to use it is an important part of ownership. If, for any reason, your treatment system has an issue you may be told by customer support to place the unit into bypass. Follow the instructions below.

This orientation of the RED handles indicates that the system is treating the water



Turning the handles, following the arrows, to place the unit into bypass



When the red handles are pointed at each other you have successfully bypassed the unit. The water is no longer being treated.
